Virtual or In-school/college sessions

Year 12: Medical Admissions (GB3)

A presentation introducing the additional admissions tests and interviews that are required for entry to Medicine.

Year 12: Why Nottingham? (can include student life)

A presentation to provide students with an overview of the University of Nottingham and provide information about academic life, facilities and support. This can also include student life where students can gain further insight into university life, including academic and social activities.

Year 12/13: Introduction to HE workshop (GB2, GB3)

This session will help students to understand their post-18 options, understand the benefits of HE and consider how to choose their university and course

Year 12/13: Applying to competitive universities (GB2, GB3)

This presentation introduces students to the concept of a competitive university, helps them to understand different selection processes and gives an overview of personal statements, including a recommended structure.

Year 12/13: Choosing your course and university (GB2)

This session allows students to take a detailed look at their options for choosing a course and university and examines some of the factors they may consider in their decision making.

Virtual or In-school/college sessions

Year 12/13: Personal statement workshop (GB3)

This workshop will provide an in-depth look at what should be included in a personal statement and help students write about their skills and experiences. There will be an opportunity for students to undertake activities to facilitate the planning process.

Year 12/13: Student finance talk

A presentation for students and/or parents to help them understand the types and amounts of support available, plus how repayment works. It can also include optional activities on budgeting and managing money.

Year 12: Higher education campus visit (GB2, GB3, GB7)

Campus visits are designed to give students an insight into university life. Current University of Nottingham students will be available to give advice and support, answer questions and lead a campus tour.
