

Privacy Notice for Ambition Nottingham Programme

Your personal data and its processing

We collect personal data from schools about high-achieving students from particular social mobility backgrounds in order to invite them to participate in the Ambition Nottingham Programme. The information schools provide will be securely stored and processed by the University of Nottingham for the purpose of managing, delivering and evaluating the Ambition Nottingham programme including future educational outcomes for participants. We define personal data as information relating to a live, identifiable individual. It also includes "special category data", which is information about racial or ethnic origin and physical or mental health, the processing of which is subject to strict requirements. "Processing" means any operation which we carry out using your personal data, for example obtaining, storing, transferring or deleting.

We only process data for the specified purposes and if it is justified in accordance with data protection law. Details of each processing purpose and its legal basis is given in the privacy notice below.

What data do we collect and with whom do we share it?

The data we collect comprises contact information, data relating to student's background and living situation

This information is used in order to assess eligibility to undertake our Widening Participation outreach programmes and for the purpose of managing, delivering, and evaluating the Ambition Nottingham programme. The legal basis for this processing is public task.

The University also uses information for the operation and evaluation of the Ambition Nottingham Programme, the legal basis for the processing of the personal data is also public task.

We also collect information relating to participating student's ethnicity and disability. This information is used by all partners to conduct equalities monitoring.

Information is also used by our partner East Midlands Widening Participation Research and Evaluation Partnership (EMWPREP) for research purposes, and the legal basis for this processing is public interest, with the additional processing condition of scientific or historical research for the special category data. How long we keep your data for

Personal data will be kept by the University in an identifiable form for two years after the completion of the academic year in which a student is eligible to apply for university. After this time, we may retain the information in an anonymous form for statistical purposes. Please see the EMWPREP Privacy notice for information on how long they retain your data.
