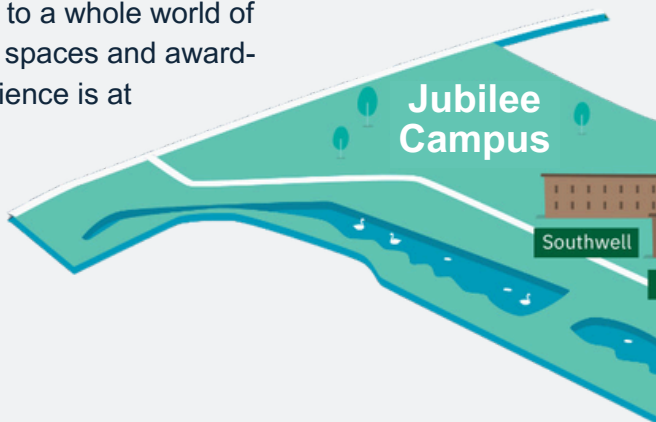

Our catered halls provide fresh, healthy, and delicious meals catering to various dietary needs. We take pride in sourcing sustainable, quality-assured ingredients, including free-range eggs, Red Tractor-assured meat, and responsibly farmed fish.

Your MealPass includes 12 meals a week; 5 breakfasts and 5 dinners, Monday to Friday, along with 2 meals at the weekend, which can be brunch or dinner. You have the option to dine flexibly either in your own hall or another hall. You also get a weekly £25 spending allowance at campus retail sites. You can top up your MealPass via the app if needed.

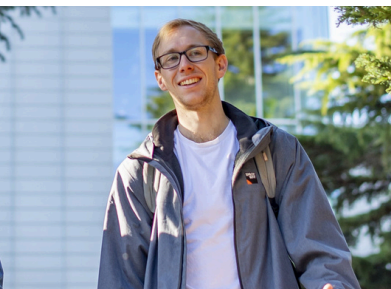



When Do Applications Open?

Applications usually open in early April, although this can change year to year. Only students who have firmly accepted their offer (conditional or unconditional) at the University of Nottingham will be able to apply for accommodation.

Paying your Fees



Accept your accommodation offer. This will include all the relevant terms.



Check your fee schedule, this will tell you what fees you have to pay and when.



Make your payments using the online portal, or your provider's preferred method.

You may be required to pay an advanced rental payment or damage deposit before your arrival date.
