

## Medical Physiology and Therapeutics Year One Scholarship 2019/20

**Guidance Notes** 

Successful applicants to the Medical Physiology and Therapeutics Year One Scholarship will receive £1,000 in year one of their course.

#### Conditions of the award are as follows:

- 1. The value of the award is £1,000 in year one only.
- Candidates will be registered on year one of the full time BSc Medical Physiology and Therapeutics course at The University of Nottingham (UK Campus).
- 3. Candidates must meet the residency requirements for a UK 'home' student.
- 4. Candidates must be in receipt of all or part of the means-tested element of the student loan for living costs, and have applied for their maximum entitlement.
- 5. Candidates must be prepared to submit a personal statement to show their interest in Science.
- 6. Candidates in receipt of any external scholarships will not be eligible.
- 7. Candidates will normally be expected to attend at least 80% of all scheduled taught classes. Failure to do so may affect eligibility for this award, or result in a successful candidate's award being withdrawn.

The closing date for receipt of applications is 29 November 2019.

## How to appeal

All applications to funds administered by the Funding and Financial Support team are assessed according to agreed guidelines and all assessments are checked prior to notifying the applicant of the outcome. If you are unsatisfied with the outcome your application you should initially contact the team to discuss your concerns (see contact details below).

If after an explanation of the assessment you believe there has been an **error or procedural inconsistency** you can ask for the outcome to be reviewed by emailing the Funding Manager, detailing the basis of your appeal. Appeals must be lodged within 2 weeks of the date of the email notifying you of the initial outcome. You will be contacted within 7 working days of receipt of the appeal with confirmation of the outcome.

It provides a process by which to question that outcome in the context of the relevant criteria and assessment guidelines. The Funding and Financial Support Management's decision on such appeals is final. Where wider issues or questions are raised, these will be dealt with in accordance with the appropriate University procedure or policy.
