If your programme of study allows you to select optional modules, including from outside your school or department, you can view information on all modules offered across the University by accessing the <u>Curriculum Catalogue</u>

## How do I search for a module using the Curriculum Catalogue?

1) To search for a module using the <u>Curriculum Catalogue</u> you first need to select the 'UK Module Catalogue' option as shown below:

2) In the next screen you will need to select the relevant academic year from the dropdown menu. For example, if completing module enrolment in May 2025 for the next academic year you would need to select 2025 from the drop down.

You then need to search the Curriculum Catalogue using a keyword, module code, or by school. If you know that you have an interest in taking a module from a particular school, you can search for all modules offered within the school by completing the search criteria as shown below:
