

## **University of Nottingham – Remote Study Travel Grant. Terms and Conditions December 2021**

### **Introduction**

In recognition that students currently studying remotely who return to campus from overseas may incur additional travel costs, the University is offering a number of support packages, one of which is a payment of up to £500 for students who meet the eligibility criteria set out in the terms and conditions below.

The latest UK Government rules and guidance should always be checked directly before travel.

### **Terms and conditions**

1. When we use the term ‘travel costs’ in these terms and conditions, we are referring to travel costs incurred by you in the period 12<sup>th</sup> November to 31 January 2022 up to a maximum of £500, but excluding the costs of PCR tests and those related to visas.
2. Subject to paragraph 3 below, in order to be eligible for the payment of up to £500 towards your travel costs (“**Payment**”), you must:
  - 2.1. be a full time home or international undergraduate or postgraduate student at the University of Nottingham (“**University**”) who is studying remotely in semester one of the 2021/22 academic year;
  - 2.2. not have entered the UK at any time in the period 1 September 2021 – 10<sup>th</sup> November 2021;
  - 2.3. be on campus by 31 January 2022 at the latest and have completed in-person registration on campus by this date; and
  - 2.4. complete your application for the Payment **by 11 February 2022 at the latest**, providing evidence of your:
    - 2.4.1. arrival in the UK; and
    - 2.4.2. travel costs and payment of them.
3. You will not be eligible for the Payment if you:
  - 3.1. do not meet the eligibility criteria set out in these terms and conditions;
  - 3.2. are a new student joining the University in January 2022; or
  - 3.3. are an exchange student due to come to the UK campus in January 2022 to commence the UK-based modules of your programme of study.
  - 3.4. do not attend for the full 2021/22 academic year, eg, because you take a voluntary interruption of studies or your studies are suspended or terminated during the academic year.
4. You must apply for the Payment by 11<sup>th</sup> February 2022. Applications for the Payment received by the University after this date will not be considered.

5. The University will only reimburse travel costs up to the maximum sum of £500. If your travel costs are less than the maximum sum, the University will reimburse the costs that have been paid by you, the student and no more.
6. The university will only cover travel costs for students and will not cover any travel costs for parents, guardians or anyone else who is accompanying the student.
7. The University will inform you of the outcome of your application for the Payment by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
8. Depending on your financial status, the University will reimburse you in May 2022 via either a tuition fee discount or bursary payment.
9. A successful application for the Payment does not preclude you from applying for other university support funds.
