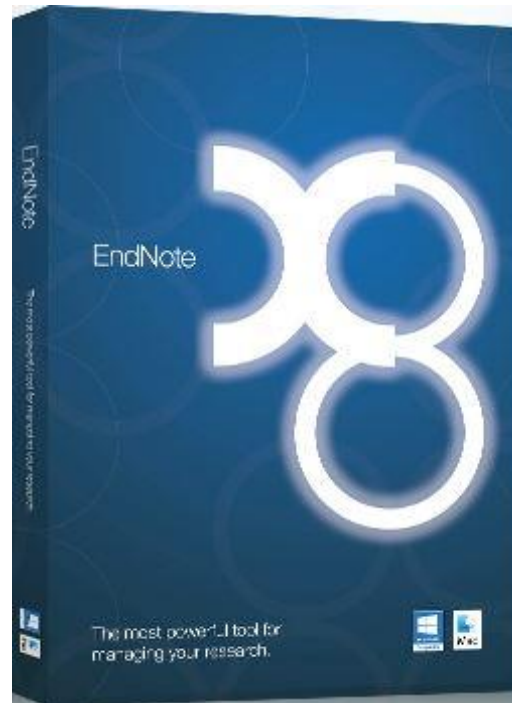

Importing references from databases



University of Nottingham Libraries
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Many online resources allow you to quickly add references to your **EndNote library**. The examples below show how you would import references to EndNote from some of the more commonly used resources using Chrome. Different browsers may have slightly different steps (e.g. in Internet Explorer, instead of clicking on the .ris file, select Open¹).

The method for downloading from resources not covered below will be very similar. 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| Google | Google Scholar | <p>There are 2 options</p> <p>i) Changing Scholar settings</p> <p>Go to Settings on the main Google Scholar search page</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set the Bibliography Manager to show links to import into EndNote • Save <p>Go back to your results in Google Scholar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on the Import into EndNote link • Click on the .enw file at the bottom of page <p>ii) Exporting from the publisher page</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on the title link within your Google Scholar results to go to the publisher homepage. • Better export options may then be available. | <p>Correct import filter is selected automatically. Only the bibliographic details will be imported, so some manual editing may be required.</p> |
| Hein | HeinOnline | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • Select MyHein Bookmarks from the drop-down then Save/Email • Enter a tag to identify this set of results (optional), then click Enter Into Research • Ignore the message about creating an account. Click here (in green – To view your saved bookmarks to date, click here) • Select the appropriate bookmarks or use the Check All button • From the Options drop-down select Export to Endnote (Journal Articles) and Submit • Click on the .enw file at the bottom of page | <p>Correct import filter is selected automatically</p> <p>Only law journal articles can be exported. Any other references will need to be entered into EndNote manually.</p> |

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| IEEE | IEEE Xplore | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • From the Export drop-down, select the Citations tab • Choose format: RIS • Click on Export • Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page | Correct import filter is selected automatically |
| JSTOR | JSTOR | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • Click Export Selected Citations • Select Export a RIS file • Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page | Correct import filter is selected automatically |
| NLM | PubMed | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • From the Send to drop-down, select Citation manager • Click Create File | Correct import filter is selected automatically |
| OVID | <p>Various databases including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AMED • CAB Abstracts • EMBASE • Food science & technology abstracts • International Pharmaceutical Abstracts • Medline • PsycINFO | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • From the Format drop-down, select EndNote • Choose the amount of information to export. It may work better if you select complete reference • Click on Export • Click on the .cgi file at the bottom of page. You may need to select EndNote as the application to open this file type | Correct import filter should be selected automatically. If it isn't, choose Ovid Nursing Database (OvidSP) as the Import Filter . |

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| Proquest | Early English Books Online | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • Click on Marked List and Download Records • Select citation format EndNote • Click on Procite, EndNote or Reference Manager • Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page | Correct import filter is selected automatically |
| Proquest | Literature Online | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • Click on Selected Items and Export/Save • Select Export directly to ProCite, EndNote or Reference Manager • Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page | Correct import filter is selected automatically |

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| University of Nottingham Libraries | NUsearch | <p>For individual records, click on the three dots next to the title</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select RIS • Click Download • Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page <p>For multiple records</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Save individual records to My Favourites by clicking on the pin icon • Select all the items to be exported and click on the three dots • Continue as above | Correct import filter is selected automatically |
| | Reading Lists | <p>From the reading list</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select Export and Export citations <p>Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page</p> | |
| Westlaw | Westlaw UK (Journals tab only) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mark references • Look for the envelope icon top right • Click the down arrow, and select Add to EndNote • Select level of information and click Submit • Click on the .ris file at the bottom of page | Correct import filter is selected automatically |
