
## **EndNote X8 Importing references from databases**

Many online resources allow you to quickly add references to your **EndNote library**. The examples below show how you would import references to EndNote from some of the more commonly used resources using Chrome. Different browsers may have slightly different steps (e.g. in Internet Explorer, instead of clicking on the .ris file, select Open<sup>1</sup>).
