White Polystyrene recycling



Nottingham University is now able to recycle all our unwanted and used polystyrene. Working with a local company Nottingham Recycling Limited who will take all our polystyrene packaging and cold boxes (that are not able to go back to their supplier) free of charge. This means that we will no longer have to place our waste polystyrene into the landfill waste bins.



The polystyrene sent to Nottingham recycling Limited is vacuum packed (to reduce its volume) where it is then sent for recycling to be broken down and reused.

There will be drop off locations set up on campus for waste polystyrene to go. Before being sent to Nottingham Recycling Limited.

Safety

For boxes that have been in the lab or had deliveries in them, they must be clean, all labels removed and sterilised before, so please wipe down with 70% IMS and left O/N. Any clean packaging can go straight to the drop off point.
