

POST GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN VETERINARY MEDICINE AND SURGERY

APPLICATION PROCESS

The School of Veterinary Medicine and Science runs a novel **Post Graduate certificate in Veterinary Medicine and Surgery**. We offer a series of **studentships** that fund your fees and a modest stipend and provides clinical teaching during an **INTERNSHIP** year within our clinical associate practices, supervised by Clinical Specialists from the School of Veterinary Medicine and Science.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. The online application process indicates a £25 fee is payable – **THIS COURSE IS EXEMPT FROM THIS FEE**
2. **The ONLINE application is used to screen application for eligibility only and is not viewed by staff shortlisting applicants.** Any mistakes or errors can easily be amended
 - a. You should upload a **CV and Letter of intent** (at the end of the application process). This will be reviewed by staff shortlisting applications and used during the interview process
 - b. You should indicate that the fees will be paid by a STUDENTSHIP and that funding is confirmed
 - c. When you select School of Veterinary Medicine and Science you are given the option of different postgraduate courses.
 - i. You should select **PGCert**
 - ii. Select the **24 month non-standard start** – The internship and stipend will only be paid for 12 months despite this
 - iii. Select the likely start date based on the advert seen
 - d. You must include your **academic history** as part of the online application – **DO NOT TICK** the box that confirms you do not want to do this. It should also be on your CV
 - e. You **DO NOT** need to confirm employment history online unless (please include on CV irrespective of whether you upload it online)
 - i. You are a graduate from a non UK/Irish school who did not complete 26 clinical placement outside their curriculum during their undergraduate course
 - ii. **AND** you have been working in veterinary practice for 2 years
 - f. The online personal statement is **ONLY** to identify which programme you are interested in (small animal or equine) and the placement or placements (you can indicate multiple). Your letter of intent can be uploaded at the end of the application process
 - g. **When detailing your references DO NOT click the email reference box.** Your referees will be send a stand form to complete from the school
 - h. **Supporting documents must include**
 - i. Your degree certificate (if you have already graduated)
 - ii. Your RCVS membership certificate (if you have already graduated)
If you are already graduated you **MUST** be an MRCVS to be eligible to apply. Conditional offers based on securing RCVS membership will not be considered
 - iii. Your English language qualifications (if English is not your first language)
If this is a requirement it must be uploaded at the time of application. Applications will not be considered without completing this requirement (where applicable)
 - iv. If you are not a graduate of UK/Ireland you must upload evidence that you have conducted 26 weeks of clinical placements outside your curriculum. (Clinical Extra Mural studies) or evidence of equivalent postgraduate employment experience.
